All students planning to enter the nursing major, including School of Adult Learning and transfer students, are eligible to apply for a scholarship. Awards to School of Adult Learning Students will be proportional to the number of credit hours taken at the full tuition rate (courses with a NURS caption are available only at full tuition rate). Part-time traditional students may receive awards related to the number of credit hours for which they are enrolled. **Interviews will be scheduled during the Nursing Visit Day in October or as requested by the applicant before the deadline. Interviews need to be scheduled on the Nursing Visit Day in October by the applicant or as requested by the applicant before the deadline. Face to face interviews are preferred, but a phone interview may be requested for extenuating circumstances.**

Requirements:

1. This scholarship is renewable for four (4) years provided a 3.0 cumulative university G.P.A. is maintained.
2. If you change majors and are no longer a nursing student, the Eleanor and Marguerite Hardacre Endowed Scholarship will not be renewed for the next year.
3. A required interview will be conducted either during our annual School of Nursing Visit Day in October, during an individual campus visit, or by phone before January 25 of the year before you enter Anderson University.
4. If you are awarded a scholarship and choose to accept the award, there is an expectation you will participate in at least one service activity annually for the School of Nursing.
5. Complete a typed essay of 100 words or less addressing the following topic:

A portion of the Anderson University Statement of Mission states, “The mission of Anderson University is to educate persons for a life of faith and service in the church and society.” State how you envision living out this mission within the profession of nursing. Please attach to this document.
