- Provide evidence of current CPR certification for healthcare providers from the American Heart Association, criminal background check, documentation of current immunizations, and a physical exam. The student must also provide documentation that he or she is free from tuberculosis.
- Complete the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) at the level designated by Anderson University School of Nursing faculty.
