

Before you begin . . . *Details and other important stuff*

■ Application form

Send your completed application and a \$25 nonrefundable application fee (check or money order payable to Anderson University) in the enclosed postage-paid envelope. Upon your acceptance to Anderson University, you will receive information regarding fees. A nonrefundable \$100 enrollment deposit is due by May 1 for applicants accepted for fall semester and by December 1 for spring semester.

■ Policy for students with disabilities

Anderson University offers reasonable accommodation to all students who qualify under ADA/ Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. To secure such accommodation, students must provide documentation of the disability and request the specific accommodation needed.

We believe that students who are qualified and have a sincere motivation to complete a college education should be given every opportunity to work toward that goal. The university provides an environment that allows students

■ Your counselor's recommendation

Fill out the top portion of the counselor recommendation form and give it to your high school guidance counselor. Your counselor is instructed to send your transcript and standardized test scores (SAT or ACT) to us. Your counselor needs to complete the recommendation form even if you have not taken these tests. To have your test scores sent directly to us, use code number 1016 for the SAT or 1174 for the ACT.

■ Counseling and health services

Anderson University offers a broad range of student health services and counseling services. Applicants are encouraged to discuss any pertinent issues or concerns with an admissions counselor so that assistance and resources will be available on campus.

■ Your pastor's recommendation

Your pastor or youth leader should serve as one reference. If you do not have a pastor or youth leader or do not wish to have a pastoral reference, other options might include a counselor, teacher, employer, or family friend. References should not be related to you in any way.

■ Campus visit

As you complete this application, we encourage you to plan a visit to Anderson University. You can arrange a campus visit on the Web at www.anderson.edu/admissions. You can also contact us by email at info@anderson.edu or by calling toll-free (800) 428-6414. Your visit may include talking with professors and students, eating meals in the dining commons, visiting classes, and touring the facilities. Parents are also encouraged to visit campus.

■ College transcript

Transfer students need to submit records of all colleges or universities attended, regardless of hours completed or reason for leaving. High school students earning college credits must also submit an official college transcript. Once we receive your transcript, we can determine which credits will transfer to Anderson University.

NOTE: *College transcripts are acceptable ONLY when mailed directly from the registrar of the college or university you previously attended.*

■ Housing policy

All single students (except seniors) under 22 years of age who are registered for 12 or more semester hours and do not live with a parent or legal guardian must reside in university housing. Accepted students will receive a housing form to indicate roommate preference. Priority for room assignments is based upon the date the enrollment deposit is received by the university.

■ Checklist

- Include check* or money order for \$25, payable to Anderson University.
- Complete and sign* top portion of pastor and counselor recommendation forms.
