Anderson University Dining Services provides friendly service and great variety in four different locations. Here is a brief description of the various dining locations and services:

Locations

THE MARKETPLACE — Olt Student Center's full-service dining room features a restaurant-style servery to satisfy a wide variety of appetites. Meals include freshly prepared entrees, specialty buffets, a garden-fresh salad bar, and a deli, complemented with a wide variety of fresh fruits, desserts, and beverages. Monotony breakers include daily specials, trendsetters and monthly theme meals.

RAVEN'S HAVEN — The Raven's Haven is the place to meet on campus. Located on the lower level of the Olt Student Center, the Raven's Haven is the home of Emma & Charlie's, which serves pizzas, grinders, and savory Italian dishes. Other favorites at the Raven's Haven include specialty salads and sandwiches, grilled hamburgers, and fries — all prepared for fast service. Daily hot-food specials and a deli enhance the dining options. Open late every evening for satisfying those late-night munch attacks!

CAFÉ OLÉ — Café Olé is located in the Decker Hall Commons for the convenience of students, faculty, and staff. Offering primarily grab-and-go selections for breakfast and lunch, it's a great place to pick up that sandwich or snack when you're in between classes or on the run. Seattle's Best Coffee®, daily hot luncheon specials, soups, and salads are also available.

CONNECTIONS — Connections is located at the Anderson University Flagship Center in the Flagship Enterprise Center (Interstate 69 at Exit 22). Offerings include continental breakfast, salads, sandwiches, and combo meal deals.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Your meal card can be used in these various locations: The Marketplace, Raven's Haven, Café Olé, Connections, and concessions.

All-you-care-to-eat meals are offered in The Marketplace. Meal equivalencies — options which allow students to use their meals outside of The Marketplace — are available at the Raven's Haven and Café Olé. Raven Dollars may pay for meals at any of the dining locations and for à la carte snacks and convenience items at the Raven's Haven and Café Olé. In addition, Raven Dollars may be used in Mocha Joe's (student-run coffee house in the Olt Student Center), Connections, and for non-textbook purchases in the University Bookstore.

MEAL PLANS

Anderson Dining Services offers five meal-plan options.:

- Plan A** — \$1,675 per semester; 200 meals, \$150 Raven Dollars
- Plan B** — \$1,540 per semester; 175 meals, \$150 Raven Dollars
- Plan C** — \$900 per semester; 100 meals, \$100 Raven Dollars
- Plan D** — All Raven Dollars (available in \$50 increments)
- Plan E** — \$425 per semester; 40 meals, \$100 Raven Dollars

CATERING — Anderson Dining Services provides a wide variety of catering services and options for student organizations, dormitories, social clubs, and special events, and also strives to meet individual needs and requests. Catered events range from coffee, punch, and hors d'oeuvre receptions to outdoor picnics, box lunches, and multiple-course meals.*

* Meals used for catered functions are limited to cardholder and one guest.

The Fine Print

MANDATORY LEVELS: Residence hall freshmen and sophomores must choose either meal plan A or B. Residence hall juniors (52-87 credit hours) must choose either meal plan A, B, or C. Seniors, students living in South Campus, Tara East, or Fair Commons, non-resident students, adult and graduate students, faculty, and staff are free to purchase any of the meal plans. Meal plans are designed for the average eater. There are approximately 285 total meals available per semester (19 meals per week, 15 weeks per semester). Additional Raven Dollars may be purchased (charged to your student account) through the Dining Services Office in Olt Student Center (minimum transaction \$50). **Raven Dollars remaining at the end of each semester may carry over from one semester to the next as long as a meal plan is purchased the following semester. Raven Dollars are not refundable or transferable. Unused meals do not carry over between semesters.**

Allowable changes in meal plans are granted during the **first three weeks** of each semester. Refunds due to early withdrawal from the university are based upon date of withdrawal and are computed according to the schedule published in the university catalog.

Semester I meal plan choice (including just Raven Dollars) automatically rolls over for semester II unless Dining Services is contacted to change the meal plan. If you have Raven Dollars left over from semester I and you opt not to have a meal plan for semester II, your Raven Dollars will be lost.
