SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. A student applying for the Dickmann Scholarship must have been a Madison County, Indiana resident for one year immediately prior to enrollment at Anderson University.
2. Scholarship funds are to be applied to the student's Anderson University account.
3. A student must carry at least 12 semester hours or be accepted as "full-time" as defined by the Registrar of Anderson University.
4. A student's primary major must be in the Falls School of Business.
5. Preference will be given to a student with demonstrated financial need.
6. The student application is available only to sophomores, juniors, and graduate students who are in good academic standing as defined in the Anderson University catalog. Scholarship funds will be available for the semester in which the student is enrolled, following application.
7. The Award is for one year. Previous applicants may reapply.
8. Preference is given to students who participate in Falls School of Business activities beyond the classroom.
9. Students must submit an essay that describes their intended career path as influenced by the entrepreneurial spirit.
10. Recipients of the Award must attend the public annual recognition meeting to receive the Award.
11. Recipients must maintain good academic and social standing.
12. The Scholarship award will range from \$1000-\$6000.
13. The Falls School of Business will make decisions on applications, and all decisions are final.
