# Criteria for Dr. James Earl Massey Leadership Scholarship

To be eligible for the Massey Leadership Scholarship students must meet all of the following criteria:

- 1) Be admitted as a first-time student (not a transfer) to Anderson University
- 2) Have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better on a 4.0 scale
- 3) Have demonstrated leadership potential through participation in church, community service, extracurricular activities, or other activities that reflect your leadership abilities
- 4) Have demonstrated openness to interacting with people whose lives have been shaped by cultures different from their own (through participation in church, community service, extracurricular activities, cultural immersion activities, or other activities that reflect intercultural awareness and/or competence)
- 5) Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident of the U.S.

\*Preference given to members of underrepresented ethnic minority groups

1. Submit a list of high school, community, and church involvement along with leadership roles you have had.
2. Respond to the following:
  - Introduce yourself by highlighting one or two significant aspects of your life story which you believe have shaped who you are today.

  - Tell us about a lesson you have learned about leadership through your high school/community/church experiences. Why do you believe that lesson is valuable?
