Criteria for Honors Program

All Anderson University applicants who feel they might contribute to and succeed in the Honors Program are strongly encouraged to apply. Applications are made by expressing interest in the Honors Program during Academic Honors Day, which is held the February prior to matriculation at AU. However, we also welcome applicants who are not able to attend Scholars' Day; these applicants may apply by submitting the Honors Program Application by the March 15 prior to matriculation. The Honors Program will be in contact with applicants to secure a specific time for their personal interview, if they are unable to participate in the Academic Honors Day interviews in February.

The AU Honors Program seeks highly-motivated, intellectually ambitious and socially responsible applicants who are committed to enriching their academic and spiritual experience at Anderson University. The most competitive applicants have a high school record of community involvement, extra-curricular participation and leadership, and outstanding academic achievement. Most successful applicants achieve a score of 1250 or above on the SAT, and a 28 or above on the ACT. Typically, successful applicants have a cumulative grade point average of 3.75 or above on a 4.0 scale. These criteria are general guidelines only, however, and some successful applicants will have achieved some but not all of them. The application process is holistic, considering a wide range of factors, which also include class standing, strength of high school curriculum, and other relevant factors.

If you are applying remotely, rather than attending Academic Honors Day, please include the following along with this application:

- One letter of reference from a high school teacher of a subject related to your proposed major
- List of your community/church related activities and involvement
- List of academic achievements and awards

I understand that in order to be eligible to compete for the Honors Program, I must (1) be admitted to Anderson University, (2) meet all Honors Program requirements, and (3) complete an Honors Program personal interview.
