Experience in K-12 school settings and post-baccalaureate teacher preparation desired. Seeking a visionary leader with strong interpersonal and communication skills, a commitment to cultural and linguistic diversity, demonstrated teaching effectiveness, technology skills to navigate data management systems, and the ability to accurately interpret state and federal regulations and stay abreast of changes in the field of teacher education. Experience in building and sustaining collaborative relationships as well as curriculum innovation and transformation desirable. In addition to administrative responsibilities the individual will teach a one course each semester.
