**Position:** Faculty, Instructor/Assistant Professor, Nursing

**Description:**

Anderson University School of Nursing invites applications for one faculty position that includes both didactic and clinical work. The non-tenure track appointment will be for 9 months and begin in August, 2019. Rank and salary will be commensurate with experience.

**Qualifications:**

This position requires an energetic person with a master's degree in nursing (or considerable work completed), current Indiana licensure or eligibility, strong skills in teaching and communication, and a practice background. The position will require practice experience in medical-surgical and/or mental health nursing. Other responsibilities will include student advising and committee work. The successful candidate will possess a maturing Christian faith and be committed to an autonomous practice of nursing along with integration of liberal arts education, global perspectives, servanthood, and community partnerships.
