## York Seminary Village

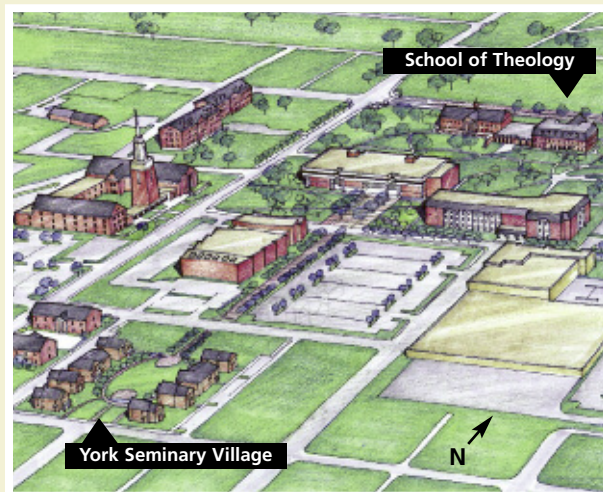
York Seminary Village is located on Walnut Street, south of Reardon Auditorium, between Sixth and Seventh Streets. The first phase of construction began in early 2006 and resulted in the completion of four housing units, located on the west side of Walnut Street. The second phase in 2007 included construction of four additional units on the east side of Walnut Street.

## Standard Amenities

- Two parking spaces are provided for each unit.
- Wired and wireless Internet access are provided through the university's computer network.
- Cable television access is available. Residents are responsible to pay for this service if they choose to order it.
- Each unit is carpeted and includes window blinds, but residents are responsible for their own furnishings.
- Each unit is equipped with a refrigerator, stove, dishwasher, in-sink garbage disposal, "instant hot-water" faucet, a washer and dryer, and central A/C.
- Each unit includes university telephone service, with voicemail provided. Residents must enter an access code to make long-distance calls.
- Each unit is all-electric (no gas). Residents are responsible to pay their own electric bills.
- Water and sewage bills are paid by the university.
- Pets are allowed in Phase One only. A pet deposit is required.

York Seminary Village is within walking distance of the School of Theology building. The following map illustrates the proximity of York Seminary Village to the SOT on the Anderson University campus.

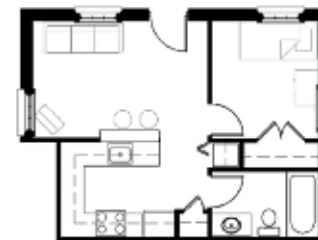


## Housing Application Process

**One-Bedroom Unit** (530 sq. feet; four units available); housing for one student, a single parent with one pre-teen child, or a married couple.



**Two-Bedroom Unit** (1,050 or 1,260 sq. feet; three units available); Housing for two same-gender single students, a single parent with children, or a married couple with children.



**Three-Bedroom Unit** (1,280 or 1,500 sq. feet; four units available); housing for three same-gender single students, a single parent with children, or a married couple with children.
